**3.** Please submit this application form with a **non-refundable application fee of \$20** in the form of check or money order made payable to the **City of Charleston.** Note in the memo line for Office of Cultural Affairs, *L'Organo.* **Upon receipt of your application**, within 7-10 days we will email you a link to the Dropbox File Request folder for submitting digital files with the required supplemental materials.

### **REQUIRED SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS**

**4. Resume and biography.** Submit with digital files (pdf, doc) a resume, including a *concise* biography with up to <u>175</u> words. If more than one performer, all biographies combined should total maximum word count.

**5. Music: Select** only **two** pieces in contrasting styles from your proposed program; recorded within the past three years. Use digital files (mp3, mp4) or include URL on YouTube/professional website.

**5.** Proposed program: Recitals are **50 minutes in length, with no intermission.** The program should have complete titles with opus numbers (catalog numbers: BWV, BuxWV, JA, K., etc), dates of compositions, composers' birth and death dates. If a piece is an extraction from a larger work, indicate the large work and the movement. List the duration of your playing time for each piece. The scheduled time does not allow for speaking, playing additional pieces, improvisations, or encores. The *L'Organo* committee reserves the right to adapt programs to avoid duplication of repertoire and to meet the overall needs of the series. <u>Upon acceptance to perform on the series and the proposed program has been approved, program notes totaling 800 words are required and must be submitted to the committee for your recital. Recital time does not allow for verbal notes.</u>
